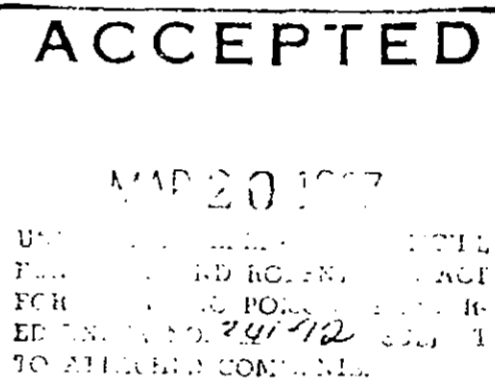

DIRECTIONS

Remove plastic cup. Hold container upright. Point spray opening away from you and press button. Apply sparingly in short bursts.

Indoors

To kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps, flying moths and certain other flying insects: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep nozzle 3 feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Cover or remove fish bowls for one hour.

To kill roaches, waterbugs, silverfish, crickets, ants and certain other crawling insects: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails **over** window and door sills and other locations.

To kill clothes moths, carpet beetles: Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior of storage containers, such as closets, chests and trunks regularly. Treatment should be repeated every thirty days, unless the articles are stored in a moth-tight container.

For house plants, spray in short bursts, holding the can 18 inches from foliage for such plants as English ivy and African violets. Spray both sides of the leaves lightly. Do not wet. Repeat as often as necessary.

Outdoors

For insects and mites on such plants as asters, azaleas, begonias, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, gladioli, irises, marigolds, petunias, roses and snapdragons. Also, for insects and mites on evergreen and small ornamental deciduous trees, shrubs and vines.

When sprayed directly on insects, this spray kills sucking insects such as aphids, leafhoppers, spotted mites, thrips (exposed) and lace bugs. Kills chewing insects such as caterpillars, climbing cutworms and Japanese beetles.

For best results spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use slow sweeping motion. Keep can 18 inches from plants. Avoid wetting foliage with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of one foot per second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat when needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray garden when temperature exceeds 90° F.

CAUTION!

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid prolonged or repeated breathing of spray mist. Do not contaminate food or feed products.

Indoors

To kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps, flying ants and certain other  
flying insects: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward  
into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 6-10 seconds for  
average room. Keep nozzle 3 feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for  
15 minutes after spraying. Cover or remove fish bowls for one hour.

To kill cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, crickets, ants and certain  
other crawling insects: Spray baseboards, corners, crevices, under doors  
and openings around sinks and pipes and on plumbing pipes, hitting the  
insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails over window and door  
sills and other locations.

To kill clothes moths, carpet beetles: Spray all articles to be treated,  
paying particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior  
of storage containers, such as closets, chests and trunks regularly.  
Treatment should be repeated every thirty days, unless the articles are  
stored in airtight containers.

To kill fleas on dogs, cats: Spray in short bursts, holding nozzle 12 inches from  
animal. Do not spray on face, ears, eyes and African violets. Spray only  
when animal is out of sight. Do not eat. Do not use often or near water.

Outdoors

For insects and mites on such plants as asters, geraniums, begonias, nary-  
anthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, gladioli, irises, larkspurs, petunias,  
roses and snapdragons. Also, for insects and mites on evergreen and  
small ornamental deciduous trees, shrubs and vines.

When sprayed directly on insects, this spray kills sucking insects  
such as aphids, leafhoppers, spotted mites, thrips (exposed) and lace  
bugs. Kills chewing insects such as caterpillars, climbing cutworms and  
Japanese beetles.

For best results spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still.  
Do slow sweeping motion. Keep can 18 inches from plants. Avoid wetting  
foliage with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1/2 gallon per acre.  
On or heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat the treatment.  
Use with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray garden when  
temperature exceeds 90° F.

mist. Do not contaminate food or feed products.
