**DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON APPLES, SOYBEANS, AND WHEAT****BEFORE USING, READ PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS ON CONTAINER LABEL**

This product is intended for use by the commercial grower or commercial applicator in conventional hydraulic sprayers, ground applicators or airplane sprayers. When applying by ground equipment, use recommended amount in sufficient water for thorough coverage; by aircraft, in 2 to 10 gallons of water unless otherwise specified. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift of spray from areas treated. Repeat applications as necessary unless otherwise specified. Consult your state experiment station or state extension service for proper timing of applications.

Apples	Apple maggot† Codling moth*†	1½ pts. / 100 gals. water	28 Do not apply during the bloom period. Apply at petal-fall and every 10 to 14 days thereafter until control is achieved. †Under heavy infestations, some sting injury may occur. *Midwest and eastern states only.
Soybeans	Mexican bean beetle, spider mites.	1½ pts. / acre	21 Do not feed or graze within 5 days of last application.
Wheat	Aphids (Greenbugs)	¾ to 1 pt. / acre	Do not apply within 14 days of grazing immature plant. Do not harvest grain within 60 days of last application.
	Brown wheat mite	⅔ to ¾ pt. / acre
