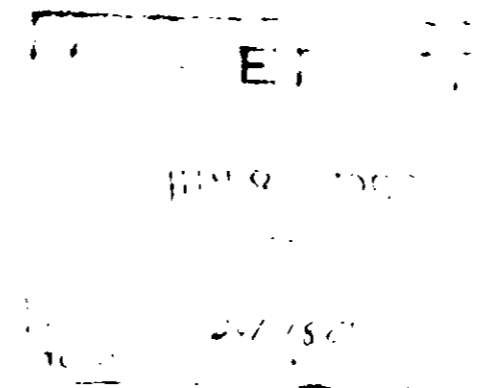

Do not use on crops used for food, forage or pasture.
