DANGER - POISON - PRECAUTIONS

CAN KILL YOU IF SWALLOWED

This product can kill you if swallowed even in small amounts: spray mist may be fatal if swallowed.



This product can kill you if touched by hands or spilled or splashed on skin, in eyes or on dothing (liquid goes through clothes).

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

Do not get in eyes, on skin, on clothing.

ANTIDOTE, FIRST AID AND MEDICAL INFORM

FIRST AID: If swallowed, induce vomiting by sticking finger do salty water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. Never give anythin If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artifical resp breathing is difficult, give oxygen.

NOTE TO PHYSICIANS

Warning symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness of chespupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and abc muscularly intravenously, depending on severity of poisoning, 1 grain each) every 15 minutes until fully atropinized as shown to tachycardia. Twenty to thirty milligrams, or more, may be require opiates or phenothiazine tranquilizers. Clear chest by postural dradministration may be necessary. Observe patient continuously exposure to any cholinesterase inhibitor until cholinesterase regeby blood tests.

Pralidoxime chloride (2-PAM; PROTOPAM chloride) may be ef according to label directions.



HANDLING AND STORAGE

Do Not Contaminate Food or Feed Products.

Isolate trea and dike to prevent runoff.

Absorb spilled liquid in soda ash, clay, sweeping compound, etc., and transfer to container for disposal by burget.

Decontininate area of spill.

DECONTAMINATION

Areas disleakage or spillage: Scrub with full-strength chlorine bleach solution followed by water wash. Repeat several times. Bury washes. Wooden floors of transportation equipment are difficult to decontinuinate and should be replaced.

DISPOSAL OF DRUMS: Drain drum completely. Add 5 gallons of water, 1 cup of detergent and 2 pounds of ive. Tighten bungs. Rotate drum to wet all surfaces and let stand for at least 15 minutes. Drain completely and rinse several times with water. Tighten bungs. Transport to a professional drum reconditioner having burning equipment for reconditioning.


