Do not apply during bloom period. Do not use on citrus seedlings. Make no more than 2 applications to mature fruit. Do not enter treated groves within 4 days of last application.

Field Crop	Pests Controlled	Rate	Interval (Days) Between Last Application and Harvest
Alfalfa	Aphids, leafhoppers, lygus bugs, grasshoppers, reduction of alfalfa weevil larvae.	1/2 to 1 pt./acre	Do not apply to alfalfa in the bloom period. Do not apply within 10 days of harvest or pasturing. Make only one application per cutting. Effective only on the cutting to which applied.
