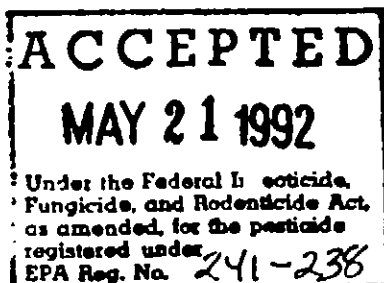
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

COUNTER 15G should be applied with a granular pesticide applicator properly calibrated to assure placement and proper dosage. See bag label for specific instructions. This label should be in the possession of the user at the time of the pesticide application.

Cover granules that may be exposed on the ends of the treated rows and turns and loading areas by deep disking immediately after treating fields.
