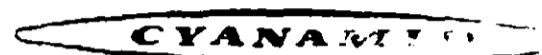

Drain completely and rinse several times with water. Tighten bungs. Transport to a professional drum reconditioner having burning equipment for reconditioning.

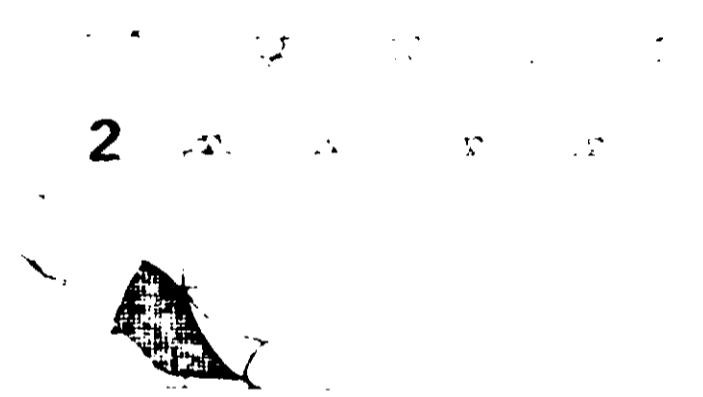

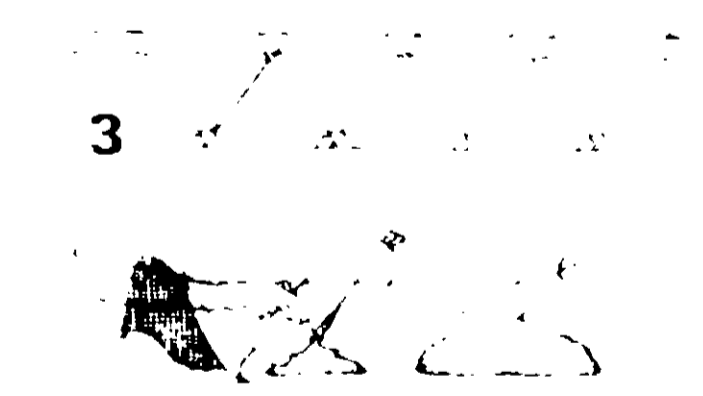
HANGING and CHARGING DIRECTIONS



IMPORTANT:
 Leave 12" or more of freeboard.
 Hang empty bag level and at desired height. Bottom of bag should be approximately 4" below backbone of cattle for range or pasture conditions. On confined cattle, bottom of bag should be started 6" to 12" over the backbone and gradually lowered for best results.



Insert one or more WARBEK charges into bag.



Stretch charges to the corners of bag to receive full amount.
 If one charge is used, allow it to stretch on each side of bag.
 If two charges are used, stretch one each side of bag.
 To save time, stretch charges into bag.
