The application referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable under FIFRA Section 3(c)(7)(B), subject to the following conditions:

1. You must submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration/registration review of your product under FIFRA when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. You are required to comply with the data requirements described in the DCI Order identified below:
 - a. Pendimethalin GDCI-108501-1267

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. 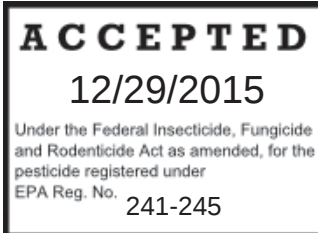

Only for formulation into a herbicide for the following uses as preemergent weed control in: 1) alfalfa, artichoke, asparagus, bermudagrass, Brassica head and stem vegetables, Brassica leafy greens, bushberry subgroup 13-07B, caneberry subgroup 13-07A, carrots, citrus fruit crop group 10-10, cotton, dry bulb onion subgroup 3-07A, edamame, edible beans, field corn, fruiting vegetables crop group 8-10, garlic, grain sorghum, grape, grass forage/fodder/hay crop group 17, grasses grown for seed, green onion subgroup 3-07B, hops, leaf lettuce, low growing berry subgroup 13-07G, melons, mint, nonbearing fruit/nut trees, nonbearing vineyards, oilseeds sunflower subgroup 20B, olive, peanuts, peas, pome fruit crop group 11-10, popcorn, potatoes, rice, soybeans, stone fruit crop group 12-12, sugarcane, sweet corn, sweet lupines, tobacco, tree nut crop group 14-12, turnip greens, vine climbing small fruits, wheat, and Christmas trees, landscape and ground maintenance, noncropland areas, ornamentals, turf grasses; 2) uses for which U.S. EPA has accepted the required data or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of pesticides.
