Subject: Supplemental Labeling - Hilling Application on Potatoes
Thimet 20G Soil and Systemic Insecticide
EPA Registration No. 241-257
Your Application Dated November 27, 1990

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the revised labeling.
 - a. Add a statement prohibiting use on heavy or clay soils for the subject at-hilling application on potatoes. As specified in the enclosed copy of the residue chemistry review, additional usage information and data would be required to support the use on heavy or clay soils.
 - b. To maintain consistency with your current registered basic labeling for the use of the subject product on potatoes, the following label restriction appearing on your basic labeling should also appear on your supplemental labeling:

Do not use for Colorado potato beetle control in the Long Island area of New York and the Del Marva Peninsula.

The Ecological Effects Branch has completed an incremental risk assessment of the subject supplemental labeling and has concluded that the subject use provide for no significant increase in exposure or risks to nontarget organisms.

Cover granules that may be exposed on the end of treated rows, turns and loading areas by deep discing immediately after treating fields.


