Subject: Amendment - Additional Labeling Changes
Amiro Fire Ant Insecticide
EPA Reg. No. 241-260
Your Application Dated December 21, 1984

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you re-lease the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Delete the terms "concentrated" and "Highly concentrated" throughout the labeling since these phrases are misleading and unacceptable. Neither the concentration nor the percentage of active ingredients has been changed (increased) for this product to warrant such claims.
 - b. Delete the phrase "Unlike ordinary fire ant insecticides that may or may not penetrate into the mound" since this phrase is a false and/or misleading comparison with other pesticides or devices.



3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.



WHY AMDRO IS SO EFFECTIVE:

1. AMDRO Fire Ant Killer is highly attractive to fire ants and harvester ants. Unlike ordinary fire ant insecticides that may or may not penetrate into the mound, AMDRO granules are carried directly into the mound by workers as food for the colony.

2. Inside the mound, AMDRO is passed to the queen, as well as to other ants. By the end of one to four weeks, the queen and most of the ants in the mound will have eaten AMDRO and died.



3. When the queen is dead, no new worker ants can be produced, so the mound dies.

Highly Concentrated. This package will treat up to 17 mounds.

HOW TO USE AMDRO:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

AMDRO is for use on lawns, turf, pasture, range grass and noncropland.

For best results, apply AMDRO Fire Ant Killer when ants are active (normally, when soil temperature is warmer than 60 degrees F)

Sprinkle 5 level tablespoonfuls of AMDRO around the base of the mound

Do not apply it directly on top of the mound or disturb the mound

Use a disposable scoop or measuring spoon (do not use a kitchen utensil).

In very large mounds, some worker ants may persist after the queen is dead. In such cases, a follow-up treatment may be necessary four to six weeks after the initial treatment.

For broadcast application of AMDRO, use a hand-held spinning disk spreader. Apply at the rate of 1/4 to 1/2 pound per 10,000 square feet or 1 to 1 1/2 pounds per acre.

NOTE: Do not use on vegetable or other food crops.

AMDRO also controls harvester ants.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling

Pets may be attracted to AMDRO, so keep them away from treated areas for at least 24 hours after application. AMDRO is not highly toxic and should not cause serious harm to pets if ingested.

AMDRO is toxic to fish. Keep AMDRO out of ponds, lakes, and streams.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORE IN A COOL, DRY, SECURE PLACE, AND KEEP CONTAINER CLOSED. WHEN PROPERLY STORED, AMDRO WILL RETAIN ITS POTENCY FOR UP TO THREE MONTHS AFTER THE PACKAGE HAS BEEN OPENED. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection
