 - b. A revised Confidential Statement of Formula with the etc. 1, and 1/ study must be submitted, or cited.
 - c. An acute in vivo study must be submitted, or cited.
4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-7-enclosures for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with 1910a Sec. 4(f). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
