Directions For Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Observe all Precautionary Statements, Limitations, and Application Instructions on the ARSENAL herbicide package label and on the package labels of any herbicides used in combination with ARSENAL herbicide. See the package labels for General Information and Weeds Controlled.

For best results, apply ARSENAL at a rate of 2 to 3 pints/acre as soon as possible after kochia plants have emerged. Certain biotypes of kochia (*Kochia scoparia*) may not be adequately controlled by ARSENAL and other herbicides with the AHAS/ALS inhibiting mode of action\*. If these biotypes are known or suspected on the treatment area, it is recommended that ARSENAL be used in combination or in sequence with other registered herbicides that have a different mode of action than ARSENAL.

Consult your supplier, consultant, appropriate state agricultural extension service representative or local American Cyanamid Company representative to obtain specific recommendations for combination or sequential treatments.

\*Mode of action is the process by which a chemical reacts within a plant to interrupt normal plant interactions necessary for growth and development. AHAS/ALS are plant enzymes that enable the plant to produce proteins.

This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application.
