**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **DO NOT** apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Consult the ASSERT leaflet label for tank mix application instructions. Consult the AVENGE leaflet label for wheat varietal restrictions and surfactant requirements.

This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application. Review label just prior to follow crop planting.

**FOLLOW CROPS**

This label is for use **ONLY** in IDAHO, OREGON, and WASHINGTON.

Peas and Lentils may be planted as rotational crops the season after a tank mix application of 0.75 pt./acre of ASSERT plus 2 pts./acre of AVENGE on wheat and barley in the following counties. If precipitation plus irrigation from the date of an ASSERT application to rotational crop planting is less than 18 inches, then follow crop injury may occur, and pea or lentil planting is not recommended until 15 months.

Peas and lentils may be planted as rotational crops 15 months after an ASSERT application in all other counties.

The following rotational crops may be planted the season after applying a tank mix application of ASSERT plus AVENGE at recommended rates on wheat and barley.

Barley	Com	Edible Bean	Safflower
Soybean	Sunflower	Wheat	

For other follow crops, follow instructions on the ASSERT leaflet label.

If ASSERT is used on a field treated during the same year with Ally<sup>1</sup>, Express<sup>1</sup>, Finesse<sup>1</sup>, Glean<sup>1</sup>, Harmo<sup>1</sup>, or Harmony Extra<sup>1</sup>, follow the most restrictive precautions, directions and recropping/rotation limitations that appear on the respective product labels.

Excessive moisture, drought, and/or cold temperatures may affect the performance of this tank mix as well as the residual effect on rotational crops.

**DO NOT** plant rotational crops in spray overlap areas, as follow crop injury may occur. The end user assumes all risks and consequences resulting from sprayer overlaps from ground and aerial applications.
