OBSERVE ALL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS IN THE
SCEPTER LEAFLET LABEL BEFORE USING

ROTATIONAL CROP RESTRICTIONS

The following rotational crops may be planted after applying SCEPTER at recommended rates in soybeans:

1. Four months after last SCEPTER application:

Small Grains
Rice

2. Eleven months after last SCEPTER application:

Corn
Edible beans
Grain sorghum
Peanuts
Tobacco

3. Eighteen months after last SCEPTER application:

Cotton

Only rotational crops harvested at maturity may be used for feed or food.

DO NOT plant other rotational crops prior to 18 months after last SCEPTER application.

DO NOT apply Classic, Canopy, or Geminil the same year as SCEPTER or injury to follow crops may occur.

In the event of a crop loss due to weather conditions, soybeans can be replanted. DO NOT work the soil deeper than 2 inches.

DO NOT GRAZE OR FEED TREATED SOYBEAN FORAGE, HAY OR STRAW TO LIVESTOCK.
