- e. The word "Childproof" is misleading in that it overstates the safety of the product and misconstrues the child-resistant packaging regulation. Revise the word "Childproof" to "Child Resistant" throughout the label.
- f. The term "more effective than sprays, foggers, and traps" must be deleted. A false or misleading comparison with other pesticides is not acceptable.
- g. The sentence, "It is a violation of Federal law . . ." needs to be separated from the sentence that follows, "For effective roach control, use"
- h. The "Precautionary Statements" section should precede the "Directions For Use" section.
- i. Delete the subheading "FIRST AID." In its place, add in a location centered and on the preceding line, the subheading "Statement of Practical Treatment."
- j. The wording "If swallowed" should be underlined.
- k. The disposal statement should read:

Wrap containers in several layers of newspaper
and discard in trash.

- l. Following the company name, please add a P.O. Box or street address.

The comments listed above should be incorporated into appropriate areas of labeling found on the bait trays, instruction sheet, and box package for both the large roach and regular roach packages.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

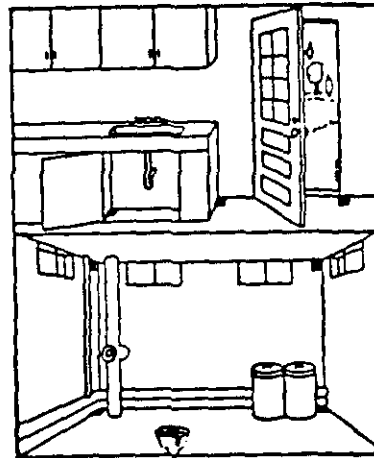
