DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. SQUADRON may be applied preplant incorporated or preemergence as stated on the SQUADRON leaflet label. This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application. DO NOT apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

SOIL APPLIED SYSTEMS

3 Pints per Acre

SQUADRON applied at 3 pints per acre provides the most consistent weed control over a wide range of environmental conditions to soybean producers utilizing low to moderate management intensity. The 3 pints per acre rate of SQUADRON is the preferred application for heavy infestations and broad spectrum control. SQUADRON may be applied preplant incorporated at 3 pints per acre from 30 days prior up to day of planting or preemergence during or up to 2 days after planting for control of the following weeds.

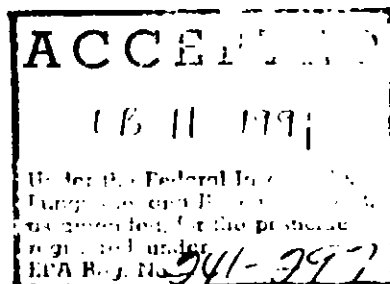
