DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply 1 to 1.5 pt. of ARSENAL per acre when making broadcast applications with helicopter or ground application equipment. Refer to mixing and application instructions on the leaflet label for proper spray volumes. Use a minimum of 1/4 percent by volume of a nonionic surfactant. Use the higher label rates of ARSENAL and higher spray volumes when controlling particularly dense or multi-layered canopies of hardwood stands, or difficult to control species.

Apply ARSENAL Applicators Concentrate at least 6 months prior to planting of red pine seedlings. Some minor inhibition of red pine height growth could occur at rates greater than 1 pt./acre.

ARSENAL may be applied without a waiting period before planting if the planting micro-sites (rows to be planted) are trenched using a TTS disc trencher or similar equipment to remove treated soil after herbicide application. A period of 72 hours is recommended between ARSENAL application and trenching to assure adequate translocation of ARSENAL in vegetation displaced by the trenching operation.

Tank mixes may be necessary for chemical control of residual conifers and other tolerant species in certain cases.

This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application.
