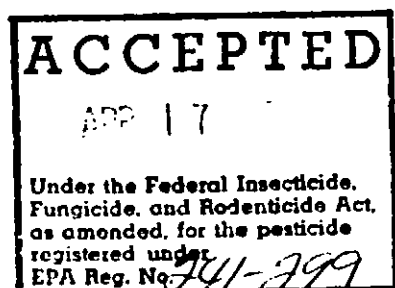

Refer to ARSENAL leaflet label to determine rates of application needed to control host plant species and to obtain directions on mixing, application and use rates for forestry site preparation and release from woody and herbaceous competition.

A postemergence application of ARSENAL herbicide Applicators Concentrate is recommended for control of most annual and perennial grasses and broadleaf weeds, vines and brambles, and woody brush and tree species for forestry site preparation and release from woody and herbaceous competition.
