**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ARSENAL herbicide Applicators Concentrate may be applied as a broadcast spray application for suppression of labeled species and release of white pine. Refer to leaflet label for species controlled listing. Some minor conifer growth inhibition may be observed when release treatments are made during periods of active conifer growth. To minimize potential white pine injury, release treatments should not be made prior to July 15.

Apply 1/2 - 1 pint of ARSENAL Applicators Concentrate per acre when making helicopter or mechanical ground spray applications. Refer to mixing and application instructions in the leaflet label for proper spray volume. Use the higher label rates for particularly dense stands or difficult to control species.

DO NOT make broadcast applications of ARSENAL Applicators Concentrate to white pine stands younger than three years old. Directed spray applications may be made with low-volume hand operated sprayers in stands of any age by targeting the unwanted vegetation and avoiding direct application to the white pine.
