The proposed supplemental label, dated 2/28/97, was derived from an approved version dated 12/15/95 for TRI-SCEPT herbicide (Approved Label). The revised supplemental label includes the rotational crop guidelines for TRI-SCEPT application in USE REGION 3.

For your review, the key sections of the revised supplemental label which are based on the approved label are highlighted and listed below.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **DO NOT** apply this product through any type of irrigation system. This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application.

A single preplant incorporated application of TRI-SCEPT may be made at the 2.33 pints per acre rate.

ROTATIONAL CROP RESTRICTIONS

The following rotational crops may be planted in Use Region 3 **NOTIFICATION** TRI-SCEPT label, which includes Nebraska (east of U.S. 81, north of U.S. 34 and also that area east of U.S. 283, south of U.S. 30, and west of U.S. 81), South Dakota (east of U.S. 81), Illinois (north of S.R. 116 east of Peoria/north of U.S. 24, east of Peoria), Wisconsin, Iowa (counties other than those listed in Use Region 2), and Minnesota (south of S.R. 210), following a soil application of TRI-SCEPT at 2.33 pints per acre.

* In Nebraska, east of U.S. 283, south of U.S. 30, and west of U.S. 81, wheat may be planted 4 months after a TRI-SCEPT application. In this geography, only field corn hybrids (~~IMI-CORN~~ ^{IMI-Corn}) which possess tolerance or resistance to TRI-SCEPT and other imidazolinone herbicides may be planted the spring of the year following an application of TRI-SCEPT (SEE NOTE ***).

** For USE REGION 3 of the TRI-SCEPT label, field corn (non ~~IMI-CORNIMI-Corn~~) may be planted as a rotational crop 18 months following the application of TRI-SCEPT unless extreme drought conditions develop (less than 15 inches of rainfall or irrigation is received from two weeks prior to the date of TRI-SCEPT application through November 15 of the same year). If the minimum rainfall requirement is not met, field corn (non ~~IMI-CORNIMI-Corn~~) may not be planted the spring of the year following the 18 month crop rotation period.

If the minimum rainfall requirement is not met, only field corn hybrids (~~IMI-CORNIMI-Corn~~) which possess tolerance or resistance to TRI-SCEPT and other imidazolinone herbicides may be planted the spring of the year following the 18 month crop rotation period (SEE NOTE ***).

*** Prior to the application of TRI-SCEPT in Use Region 3, it is recommended that users contact their chemical dealer, seed supplier, or American Cyanamid to obtain information regarding the availability of imidazolinone tolerant field corn hybrids (~~IMI-CORNIMI-Corn~~) which are adapted to your area.

**** For USE REGION 3 as defined in the USE AREA section of the TRI-SCEPT label; canola, strawberries, cabbage, tomatoes, potatoes, carrots, celery, cole crops, garlic, onions, spinach, asparagus, cauliflower, and broccoli may be planted 26 months after a TRI-SCEPT application. Other crops may be planted 18 months after a TRI-SCEPT application.

Consult the TRI-SCEPT label for spraying and application information, weeds controlled, and use rates. When tank mixing, always follow the more restrictive label.

Use of TRI-SCEPT herbicide in accordance with label directions is expected to result in normal growth of rotational crops in most situations; however, various environmental and agronomic factors make it impossible to eliminate all risk associated with the use of TRI-SCEPT and, therefore, rotational crop injury is always possible.
