This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application.

GENERAL INFORMATION

TRI-SCEPT provides control of broadleaf and grass weeds when applied preplant incorporated. TRI-SCEPT can be applied to conventional soybeans. Sulfentrazone-containing products (such as Authority¹ Broadleaf or Canopy² XL) may be tank-mixed with TRI-SCEPT when applied early preplant incorporated only for enhanced control of weeds common to soybean production.

When tank-mixing herbicides, always follow the most restrictive label.

Use of TRI-SCEPT herbicide in accordance with label directions is expected to result in normal growth of rotational crops in most situations; however, various environmental and agronomic factors make it impossible to eliminate all risks associated with the use of this product and, therefore, rotational crop injury is always possible.
