SUBJECT: New Supplemental Label for TRI-SCEPT® followed by Roundup™ Ultra
 on Roundup Ready™ Soybeans
 Tri-Scept® Herbicide
 EPA Registration No. 241-307
 Your Application Dated May 4, 1998

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided you make the following change:

- Delete the recommendation to add a non-ionic surfactant from the first sentence of the Directions For Use, since the Roundup™ Ultra label prohibits the use of such surfactants. The revised sentence should read as follows:

“For the Roundup Ultra application, as specified on this label only, the addition of ammonium sulfate (spray grade) at 2.5 lbs/acre is recommended.”

At your discretion, you may also delete the phrase “as specified on this label only” from the above statement.

A stamped copy of the supplemental label is enclosed for your records. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. The use of TRI-SCEPT herbicide not consistent with this labeling may result in injury to crops. **DO NOT** apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application.

GENERAL INFORMATION

TRI-SCEPT may be applied preplant incorporated (SEE USE AREA) to Roundup Ready soybeans for early season weed control and residual activity on broadleaf weeds and grass weeds. If weeds emerge later, Roundup Ultra may be applied postemergence for weed control. For sequential treatments, a sufficient time period should elapse between treatments to allow an appropriate assessment of weed control needs.

USE RATE

Apply TRI-SCEPT preplant incorporated at 2.33 pints per acre. Apply Roundup Ultra postemergence at 1 pint per acre.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For the Roundup Ultra application, as specified on this label only, the addition of a non-ionic surfactant (containing at least 80% active ingredient) at 0.25% v/v (1 quart in 100 gallons of spray mixture), AND ammonium sulfate (spray grade) at 2.5 lbs/acre, is recommended. Apply when weeds are 1-3 inches tall.

Note: **DO NOT** apply Roundup Ultra postemergence to non-glyphosate resistant soybeans.

Refer to the TRI-SCEPT product labeling for use area and a description of Use Regions.

ROTATIONAL CROP INFORMATION

Refer to rotational crop restrictions listed in the TRI-SCEPT product labeling.

Use of TRI-SCEPT herbicide in accordance with label directions is expected to result in normal growth of rotational crops in most situations; however, various environmental and agronomic factors make it impossible to eliminate all risks associated with the use of this product and, therefore, rotational crop injury is always possible.
