

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

BEFORE USING, READ PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS ON BAG

COUNTER CR should be applied with a granular pesticide applicator properly calibrated to assure placement and proper dosage. See label for specific instructions. This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

Cover granules that may be exposed on the ends of the treated rows and turns and loading areas by deep disking immediately after treating fields.
