DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **DO NOT** apply this product through any type of irrigation system. This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application.

A single preplant incorporated or preemergence application of SQUADRON may be made at the 3 pint per acre rate.

ROTATIONAL CROP RESTRICTIONS

The following rotational crops may be planted in the southern Iowa counties of Mills, Fremont, Montgomery, Page, Adams, Taylor, Union, Ringgold, Clarke, Decatur, Lucas, Wayne, Monroe, Appanoose, Wapello, Davis, Jefferson, Van Buren, Henry, Lee, and Des Moines following a soil application of SQUADRON at 3 pints per acre.

Soybeans	No restrictions
Wheat	4 months
Rice	Spring following SQUADRON application
Field Corn	9.5 months*
Barley, Edible Beans, Grain Sorghum,	11 months
Oats, Peanuts, Tobacco	
Sugar Beets	26 months
Other Crops	18 months

*Field corn may be planted as a rotational crop in the spring of the year following SQUADRON application unless extreme drought conditions develop (less than 15 inches of rainfall or irrigation is received from two weeks prior to the date of SQUADRON application through November 15 of the same year).

If the minimum rainfall requirement is not met, only field corn hybrids which possess tolerance or resistance to SQUADRON and other imidazolinone herbicides may be planted the spring of the year following a SQUADRON application. Contact your chemical dealer, seed supplier, or American Cyanamid to obtain information regarding the availability of imidazolinone tolerant field corn hybrids which are adapted to your area.

Other Iowa counties must follow the rotational crop restrictions for SQUADRON Use Region 3 according to the SQUADRON label. Consult the SQUADRON label for spraying and application information, weeds controlled, and use rates. When tank mixing, always follow the more restrictive label.

Use of SQUADRON herbicide in accordance with label directions is expected to result in normal growth of rotational crops in most situations; however, various environmental and agronomic factors make it impossible to eliminate all risk associated with the use of SQUADRON and, therefore, rotational crop injury is always possible.
