### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **DO NOT** apply this product through any type of irrigation system. This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application.

Trifluralin products (such as TRI-4® HF herbicide) can be tank mixed with STEEL and applied preplant incorporated if heavy or difficult to control infestations are anticipated from broadleaf and grass weeds listed in the STEEL leaflet. Refer to the soybean section of the trifluralin product label for specific use rates, application methods and application timings based on soil texture and soil organic matter content.

Observe all precautions and limitations on the trifluralin product label. When tank mixing, always follow the more restrictive label.

Use of STEEL in accordance with label directions is expected to result in normal growth of rotational crops in most situations; however, various environmental and agronomic factors make it impossible to eliminate all risks associated with use of this product and, therefore, rotational crop injury is always possible.
