## GENERAL INFORMATION

Apply LIGHTNING herbicide only on selected field corn hybrids (CLEARFIELD corn) warranted by the seed company to possess resistance/tolerance to direct application of LIGHTNING.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application.

DO NOT apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

## ROTATIONAL CROP GUIDELINE

Cotton may be planted at the following intervals after a LIGHTNING herbicide application if the criteria are met.

### I. 9.5 Months after an application of LIGHTNING

- Greater than 16 inches of rainfall and/or irrigation received following application of LIGHTNING through October of the application year, and
- only in the states listed below:

Georgia	Kentucky	Louisiana
Mississippi	Missouri	N. Carolina
S. Carolina	Tennessee	Virginia

### II. 18 Months after application of LIGHTNING

- If the above criteria are not met, rotation to cotton must be at least 18 months following application of LIGHTNING.
