The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- Reinstate the Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and User Safety Recommendations sections in the Precautionary Statements section.

According to 40 CFR 156.10(i)(1)(ii), only the directions for use may appear on printed or graphic matter which accompanies the pesticide. All of the Precautionary Statements must appear on the container label.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
