Dear Mr. Levey:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section under 3(c)(7)(b) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable provided you make the following changes:

- 1. In the "Ingredients Statements" section revise the chemical formula for Dimethomorph to add a dash after the number "4" in (3,4-dimethoxyphenyl) so that the chemical formula reads, "(E and Z) 4-[3-(4-chlorophenyl)-3-(3,4-dimethoxyphenyl)-1-oxo-2-propenyl]morpholine".
- 2. Remove the reference "Product of Brazil".

Only for formulation into a fungicide for the following uses: 1) brassica leafy vegetables, bulb vegetables, cucurbit vegetables, fruiting vegetables, ginseng, grapes, hops, lettuce, lima bean, potato, taro, tobacco, turnip greens, or on ornamental crops; 2) uses for which U.S. EPA has accepted the required data or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and 3) uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with U.S. EPA requirements. Consult BASF Corporation before using this product for formulating purposes. Each formulator is responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their end-use product(s). This product may be used to formulate products for any additional uses not listed on the technical label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such uses.

Storage and Disposal

DO NOT contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a well-ventilated area separately from fertilizer, feed and foodstuffs. Avoid cross-contamination with other pesticides. Keep container closed when not in use. Spillage or leakage should be contained, carefully swept up, and collected for disposal.
