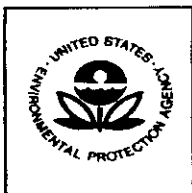

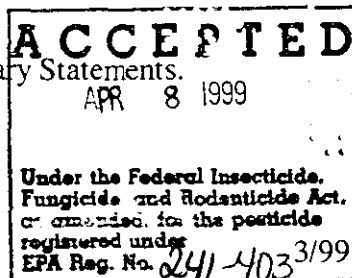

This pesticide is toxic to fish.
