3. Submit production information (pounds or gallons produced) for these products for the fiscal year in which the use on tomatoes was conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA Section 29. The fiscal year begins October 1 and ends September 30. Production information must be submitted to the Agency no later than November 15, following the end of the preceding fiscal year. This information must be submitted to:

4. Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

Acrobat MZ and Acrobat 50WP

(a) Revise the first sentence as follows: "Observe all Directions and Precautionary Statements . . .".

Acrobat 50WP

- (b) Delete all references to metalaxyl as all current metalaxyl registrations are limited to seed treatments only.
- (c) Add a brief explanation as to why mefenoxam, specifically, should not be used as a tank mix partner.
- (d) Delete the last paragraph on page 5 regarding tank mixing since the product label does not specify any chemicals that are appropriate tank mix partners. Future addition of such labeling will be considered if the label is revised to specify specific tank mix partners. Refer to the enclosed PR Notice 82-01.

(e) You are required to revise your first aid statements by 10/1/01 to comply with PR Notice 2000-3.

5. Submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, these amendments will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of the conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. FOR CONTROL OF LATE BLIGHT IN FIELD GROWN TOMATOES

OBSERVE ALL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS ON THE ACROBAT 50WP CONTAINER LABEL BEFORE USING. 5

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. THIS LABELING MUST BE IN THE POSSESSION OF THE USER AT THE TIME OF FUNGICIDE APPLICATION. DO NOT apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ACROBAT 50WP can be used in a preventative spray program to manage late blight (*Phytophthora infestans*) in field grown tomatoes. Maximum results can only be achieved by thorough plant coverage and use in a rigorous preventive program. ACROBAT 50WP must be used in accordance with this label. It is recommended that this product be used within an Integrated Pest Management Program.

In order to reduce the risk of the development of fungicide resistance, ACROBAT 50WP must be used as a tank-mix with fungicides, <u>EXCEPT MEFENOXAM OR METALAXYL</u>, registered for late blight control in field grown tomatoes.

Carefully read, understand, and follow all directions and precautions.

Applications should be made on a 5-10 day spray schedule up to harvest. Disease pressure and environmental conditions will determine the length of the spray interval required. Prior to the onset of conditions favoring infection, apply every 7-10 days. When environmental conditions have been conducive for disease, or when disease has been detected within the field or nearby, a 5-7 day schedule is recommended.

Sprayers should be properly calibrated before application. Determine the exact number of acres to be sprayed, and output per acre to determine how much ACROBAT 50WP and water is needed for accurate applications.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Fill the spray tank until it is approximately 1/2 full with clean water. Slowly, add ACROBAT 50WP to the spray tank while agitating. Agitation must be engaged prior to the addition of the product to obtain a complete and uniform mixture of ACROBAT 50WP.

COMPATIBILITY

The tank-mixing behavior of this fungicide with other pesticides has not been fully investigated. If tank mixing with other pesticides is desirable, conduct a jar test with rates and volumes of carrier typically used in an agricultural application. Look for signs of separation, globules, sludge, flakes or other precipitates. DO NOT tank mix with the other pesticide if the jar test with ACROBAT 50WP has indicated incompatibility.

TANK MIXES WITH FUNGICIDES

DO NOT apply ACROBAT 50WP alone. ACROBAT 50WP must be used in a tank-mix with fungicides, EXCEPT MEFENOXAM OR METALAXYL, registered for late blight control.

Refer to the respective tank-mix partner labeling for rates, methods of applications, proper timing, restrictions and precautions. Always use in accordance with the more restrictive label restrictions and precautions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN FIELD GROWN TOMATOES

GROUND APPLICATIONS

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Maximum benefit of ACROBAT 50WP from foliar applications requires thorough coverage of the plant. To obtain thorough coverage of foliage, use proper spray pressure and a minimum of 20 gallons per acre.

AERIAL APPLICATIONS

Prior to aerial application, check the aircraft for uniformity of spray pattern, spray swath width and output. Use hollow cone or whirlplate nozzles. Point nozzles straight down or slightly backward. Uniformly apply with properly calibrated aerial equipment in 20 or more gallons of water per acre. If foliage is dense, use an output that will ensure optimum fungicide penetration. Spray swaths should be marked using flaggers who are in completely enclosed vehicles, by counting rows, or by using some other marking device.

DO NOT apply when weather conditions favor drift.

ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS

To reduce the possibility of developing *Phytophthora infestans* resistance to both ACROBAT 50WP and to mefenoxam or metalaxyl products, the tank mixing of ACROBAT 50WP with any of these products is <u>STRICTLY PROHIBITED</u>.

Phytophthora infestans strains have developed resistance to some crop protection products after repeated use. Since the development of resistance cannot be predicted, ACROBAT 50WP should always be used in a resistance management program. Tank mixing and thorough spray coverage are necessary to minimize the development of Phytophthora infestans strains with resistance to ACROBAT 50WP.
