At your next label printing, or within eighteen (18) months of the date of this letter, whichever comes first, you must incorporate this supplemental labeling into the main product labeling.



**Active Ingredient\*:**

pendimethalin: N-(1-ethylpropyl)-3,4-dimethyl-2,6-dinitrobenzenamine ..... 38.7%

**Other Ingredients:** ..... 61.3%

**Total:** ..... 100.0%


**Directions For Use**

When following the instructions on this supplemental label, the user must have this label and the entire Prowl H<sub>2</sub>O container label in possession at the time of pesticide application.

**Product Information**

Prowl H<sub>2</sub>O is a selective herbicide for controlling most annual grasses and certain broadleaf weeds as they germinate. Refer to the Prowl H<sub>2</sub>O container label for a complete list of weeds controlled.

**Application Instructions**

Prowl H<sub>2</sub>O may be applied by ground or air.

**Use Methods and Timings**

With a single application, uniformly apply Prowl H<sub>2</sub>O to artichoke up to 3.0 pints per acre as a broadcast spray to the soil surface at least 60 days prior to harvest. Application must be made pretransplant to artichoke, at no less than 1 to 2 days prior to transplanting.

**Restrictions and Limitations**

- **DO NOT** apply postemergence over the top of or to foliage of artichoke because severe injury may occur.
- **DO NOT** apply more than 3.0 pints per acre per season when utilizing the 60 day preharvest interval.
- **DO NOT** apply within 60 days before harvest.
- If more than 3.0 pints per acre (up to 8.2 pints per acre) of Prowl H<sub>2</sub>O is applied, **DO NOT** harvest artichoke until 200 days after application.
- **DO NOT** feed forage or graze livestock in treated fields.
