**ANTIDOTE:** Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Follow by 8 tablespoonful of medicinal mineral oil (not salad or vegetable oils). Have victim lie down and keep warm. Call a physician immediately.

**DANGER:** Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not breathe fumes.

**GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR RATS AND MICE:** Place bait at 8-10 foot intervals in locations where rats and mice feed, water, or travel. Baits must be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets, and domestic animals; or in tamper-proof bait boxes. Collect and destroy all uneaten baits after completion of the control program.

**TO PREPARE BAITS FOR RATS AND MICE:** Mix one teaspoonful of Phosphorous Paste to 2 ounces of suitable bait material. When using recognizable foods change their shapes by rolling, grinding, cubing, etc. **DO NOT USE FOODS WHICH WILL BE RECOGNIZED BY CHILDREN. DO NOT USE FOODS SUCH AS COOKIES, CANDIES, NUTS, ETC., WHICH MIGHT BE ATTRACTIVE TO CHILDREN.** Bear in mind that when baits are prepared in small pieces they can be carried by rodents from otherwise safe placements. Place baits in 1/2 inch mesh closed wire baskets that are securely anchored. Phosphorus paste may also be mixed with ground meat or fish. Use 2 table-spoonful of Phosphorus Paste to 1 pound of bait, or 1 pound of Phosphorous Paste to nine pounds of bait. Distribute in teaspoon quantities. **CAUTION:** Dogs and cats will actively search for fish or meat baits. Place baits where they will not be fed upon by these animals.

**SUGGESTED PROCEDURE FOR SAFE DISPOSAL OF THIS CAN:** Do not re-use this can. Completely empty the contents and bury the unused chemical at least 18 inches deep in an isolated location away from water supplies. Pour one pint of water (or less if can is too small) into the empty can and add one tablespoonful of household detergent. Rotate the can carefully to wet all inner surfaces with the solution. Bury the rinse solution at least 18 inches deep in an isolated location away from water supplies. Punch holes in the top and the bottom of the can, crush the can and bury deeply in an isolated location.
