



**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

Apply this product only as specified on the label.

**General Directions:** Apply with a low-pressure sprayer equipped with a pin-stream or flat-fan type spray nozzle. Spray surfaces only until coated with a dew-like mist. Avoid run-off. Apply to all insect feeding sites and harborage. Also treat adjacent exposed surfaces where insects may occur when they come out of hiding. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Applications of this product in the food areas of food handling establishments other than as a crack and crevice treatment are not permitted.

**Food Handling Establishments:** Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

**Food Areas** - application limited to crack and crevice treatment only. Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas when food is exposed and facility is in operation (also would be considered a food area).

Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide where roaches, waterbugs and silverfish hide, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housing, junction or switch boxes. Prior to application de-energize electrical equipment. After application, allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in the ON position.

Aids in the control of pantry pests (exposed stages of sawtooth grain beetle, flour beetle, rice weevil, cigarette beetle, and indian meal moth) which come in contact with treated surfaces.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surface.

**Serving Areas** - Facilities where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, under elements of construction, into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.)

**Non-Food Areas** - Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Apply as a spot treatment to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

**Locations Other Than Food Handling Establishments.**

**Cockroaches:** Thoroughly treat the infested area. Spray baseboards, cracks and crevices, around windows and door frames, the under surfaces of shelves, drawers and work tables, behind and under cabinets, refrigerators, sinks and stoves, in and around waste containers, switch panels, junction boxes, floor drains and other places where cockroaches hide or rest.

**Ants:** Apply to trails and places where ants enter premises such as window frames and door frames. Also spray ant hills and runways out of doors.

**Silverfish:** Apply to localized areas infested by these insects.

**Brown Dog Ticks:** Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do Not spray animals.

**Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, Sowbugs, Scorpions, And Spiders:** Thoroughly spray the interior and exterior perimeter of the infested premises. For Clover mites give special attention to window frames.

**Fleas, Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes (outdoors only):** Spray infested areas thoroughly outside. Treat outside surfaces of screens, door, window frames, foundations, patios and other areas where insects may enter.

**Insect Control in Research Facilities:** The use of this product in and around research animal quarters for insect control and to induce mutations in tumor chromosomal enzyme activity in these animals.
