DIRECTIONS

In making use emulsions, add water to disinfectant rather than the disinfectant to the water. Use lukewarm water wherever possible.

In the following usages, be sure all dirt is swept up and removed before applying disinfectant, and make sure disinfectant solution comes in contact with all infected areas.

FOR URINALS AND TOILETS: Clean daily with Solution A. When toilet room has been cleaned, the pailful of solution should be utilized by pouring it down the urinal drains, thereby deodorizing the drains and traps.

TO AID IN DISINFECTING of water closets, toilet bowls—clean and flush the hopper each day with Solution A. Wash off toilet seats as well as entire surface of vessel.

IN PUBLIC PLACES—Schools, hotels, theatres, stores, office buildings, colleges, etc.—Wash freely all floors, desks, etc., with Solution A, making sure entire surface is wetted.

DIRECTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING WHERE DISINFECTION IS DESIRED

FOR CLEANING—Use Solution B. Wash floors with this solution regularly. Adding small amounts of this disinfectant to regular mopping solutions will aid materially in cleaning and deodorizing.

AS A CLEANER AND DEODORIZER—For washing floors, woodwork, sinks, refrigerators, basements, carpets, telephones, etc.—Add 3 to 4 tablespoonfuls of this Disinfectant to one pail of your regular scrubbing solution.

FOR SWEEPING—Use Solution A. Sprinkle over area to be swept; or moisten sawdust or other sweeping material with this solution.

VENTILATORS—Insert a gallon of this disinfectant into tank of the air washing machine.

SOLUTION A: Mix 1 part of Disinfectant with 60 parts of water for disinfecting.

SOLUTION B: Mix 1 part of Disinfectant with 120 parts of water for cleaning only.
