DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats, and flying moths: Close room and spray this unit 4 - 5 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space in the room. Spray upward using a circular motion. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying.

To kill crawling insects such as roaches, waterbugs and ants: Aim spray directly at insects where possible. For roaches and waterbugs spray into cracks, crevices and darkened areas behind sinks, cabinets, stoves, baseboards and floor coverings. For ants, spray the nests liberally. Spray ant trails around door sills, window frames, etc. Repeat treatments as often as necessary to obtain control.

CAUTION!

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Contents under pressure. Do not place container on stove or radiator or where temperature will exceed 120°F. Do not puncture or throw container into fire.

Shake or remove all contents immediately prior to application.
