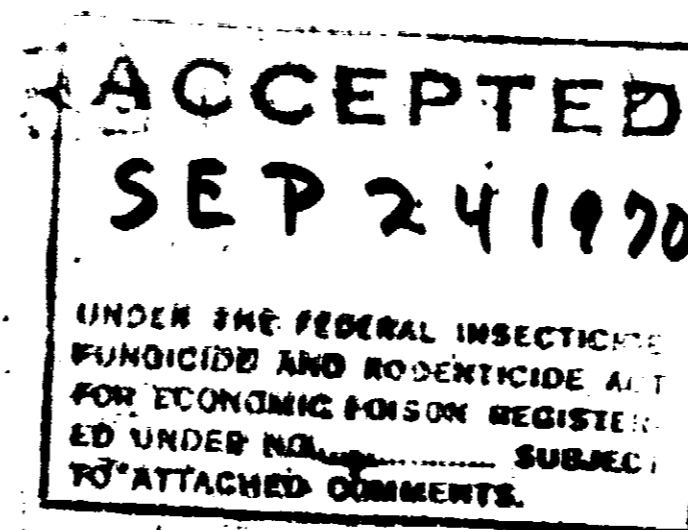

ALGACIDE will suppress algae according to directions. Always use in swimming pool treatment. ALGACIDE retains its full effectiveness.

Add one gallon of ALGACIDE per 10,000 gallons of water. After application add one quart per 10,000 gallons of water after heavy rainfall. If fresh water sediment is present, remove and let stand overnight. Add fresh water added to replace lost water and re-treat again with the initial dose.

**CAUTION:** Avoid contamination with skin and clothing. If irritation persists, discontinue use.

Do not mix with soaps or detergents. Rinse container thoroughly with water.

**ALGACIDE** will suppress growth of algae in swimming pool water when used according to directions. **ALGACIDE** is fully compatible with the usual chemicals used in swimming pool treatment, and imparts no odor or taste to pool water. **ALGACIDE** retains its full strength indefinitely while stored in this container.

**DIRECTIONS**

Add one gallon of **ALGACIDE** for each 50,000 gallons of water. After first application add one quart per 50,000 gallons once a week and also after every heavy rainfall. If fresh water is added, use same rate as initial dosage. Where sediment is present, remove the bulk of it and add the initial dose of **ALGACIDE** and let stand overnight. The precipitated algae should then be removed and fresh water added to replace the water spent in desedimentation and the pool treated again with the initial dose.

**CAUTION:** Avoid contamination of food. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes, in case of contact, flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists get medical attention.

Do not mix with soaps or like cleaners. Protect from freezing. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
