For use in homes, bakeries and restaurants. Also popular for use in stores, markets, hotels, motels, dairies, canneries, breweries and meat packing plants, where foods and food stuffs are handled.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. KEEP UPRIGHT WHILE SPRAYING.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Sandflies, Small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a low, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cubic feet). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Vacate premises. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

To Kill Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Ants, Scorpions, Centipedes, Sowbugs, Spiders, Fleas: Spray base boards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails around windows and door sills and other locations. For fleas, thoroughly spray animal quarters and sleeping area. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Wasps and Hornets: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible.

To Kill Clothes Moths, Carpet Beetles: Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior of storage containers such as closets, chests and trunks regularly. Treatment should be repeated every thirty days unless the articles are stored in a moth-tight container.

To Kill Bedbugs: Spray mattresses thoroughly, especially around seams and tufts. Spray bedstead, baseboards and floorboards. Repeat frequently.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

When used in an enclosed area do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

If used in a food processing or preparation area, foods should be removed or covered during treatment. Food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before re-use. Do not treat while food processing is underway.

Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.
