


HOW TO USE

TO DISINFECT:

Toilet Bowls - Remove water from bowl. Then pour four ounces of Bowl Cleaner into bowl making certain to wet and swab all surfaces thoroughly, including under the rim. Allow to remain 10 minutes before flushing. Pre cleaning is needed when gross filth is present.

Toilet Tanks - Shut off and remove water. Saturate mop and clean surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain 10 minutes before flushing.

Urinals - Hold clean mop over urinal and saturate with Bowl Cleaner. Swab all surfaces, grooves and outlets. Swab inside of pipe. Allow to remain 10 minutes before flushing. Use daily for optimum cleanliness.

Porcelain - Saturate mop with Bowl Cleaner and wet surface thoroughly. Allow to remain 10 minutes. Then rinse with clear water.

TO SANITIZE:

Toilet Bowls - For daily maintenance, use 1 1/4 ounces each application, using same procedure as for disinfection.

TO DEODORIZE:

Urinals - Remove trap screen and pour 4 to 8 ounces around drain opening and into drain for deodorization.

TO CLEAN:

Tile Floors - Dilute Bowl Cleaner with equal parts water and mop onto stained area. Then clean entire floor using a recommended dilution of good quality cleaner or detergent.

Porcelain - Dilute with 4 parts water. Apply and rinse immediately.

Do not use on marble or resilient floor tiles.

Do not use on cracked or chipped enamel.

Avoid prolonged contact of cleaner with plated plumbing fixtures such as chrome, nickel, etc. Always flush with clear water after contact.
