DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.
Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinseate that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal, State or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.
Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other state or local procedures.
TO KILL FLIES: Close all windows and doors and spray towards the ceiling, then in all cracks and crevices and around the base boards. Leave the room closed for about ten minutes, longer if the room is large. This treatment will also free the room of mosquitoes and other winged insects. Repeat as often as necessary.
ROACHES, HORNETS, SPIDERS AND CENTIPEDES: Apply as above, and when the insects from their hiding places give them a second spraying. This will also kill spiders and hornets. Repeat application as often as practical.
Bedbugs: After closing the room, spray the bed frames, springs and mattress. The fumes will drive the bugs into the open when a second spraying is needed. Cracks around infested rooms should be sprayed as needed.
Ants: Spray under beds, chests and closets thoroughly, clothes lightly. Keep doors closed for a half hour, depending upon size of closet. Repeat application unless treated articles are stored in moth-tight containers.
ANIMALS: Apply as above, and when the insects come from their hiding places give them a second spraying. This will also kill spiders and hornets. Repeat application as often as practical. Spray ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where the pests enter the premises.
FLEAS ON DOGS: Spray the animal's coat of hair, also the bedding and kennel. Repeat at intervals of two days for one week. Best results will be obtained if the dog is first washed in lukewarm water with a good animal soap or preferably in water to which has been added a reliable coal-tar disinfectant. Do not wet dog's skin. Repeat application when necessary but not more than once in three weeks.
PERMETHRIN FLY SHOT is a clear, amber fluid, with an agreeable, aromatic odor, specially prepared for the purposes named on this label. It will not permanently stain or discolor fabrics, furniture, wallpaper, wood or metal work.
 It is supplied in the form in which it is to be used. All that is necessary to apply it is a hand sprayer, which can be bought at any hardware or agricultural supply house. If spraying on an extensive scale, a compressed air sprayer might be used.
 When stored, the container should be kept tightly sealed to prevent evaporation and away from heat or toward an open flame.
