The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Delete all sanitization claims on the label.
 - b. Delete "General Classification" on the label.
 - c. The signal word for this product is "DANGER." If you wish to change your signal word, you must submit toxicity data in support of that change.
 - d. Delete the word "milk."
 - e. Delete the words "or fatal."
 - f. Sodium Carbonate must be deleted from the active ingredient and place in the inert ingredient. Adjust your inert ingredient percentages accordingly.
 - g. Delete the statement "Only For Sale To, Use And Storage By Service Persons."
 - h. Include a 10-minute contact time for the disinfection section.

j. Change "First Aid" to "Statement of Practical Treatment."


2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

**DIRECTIONS
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

This is a Federal Law to use this product in accordance with its label.

FOR CLEANING

Surfaces to be cleaned should be kept as dry as possible with a solution of Strike Out per gallon of water. Rinse treated areas with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION

To disinfect floors and other hard surfaces in homes, schools, hospitals, recreation areas, and other public buildings, treat with a solution containing 1 1/2 ounces of Strike Out per gallon of water. Surfaces that are highly soiled should be cleaned with 2 ounces of Strike Out per gallon of water. If the treated surfaces are to be used for food preparation, they should be washed with clean water of drinking quality.

To disinfect walls, ceilings, and other surfaces, apply a solution containing 2 ounces of Strike Out per gallon of water. Surfaces that are highly soiled should be cleaned with 2 ounces of Strike Out per gallon of water.
