DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON LAWNS

Apply Super D WEEDONE any time weeds are growing actively. Spray when the air is calm to avoid spray drift that might injure desirable plants.

Newly seeded lawns may be treated after they have been mowed at least twice. To re-seed small areas in treated lawns, wait at least 3 weeks after spraying. A good rain or deep watering should occur during this period.

A few weeds, such as henbit that grow during the winter, as well as wild garlic and onion that emerge early in the year, should be sprayed in early spring.

AMOUNTS TO USE IN AMCHEM METER-MISER*

SUPER D WEEDONE	ADD WATER TO MAKE	SQUARE FEET COVERED
12 oz	5 gallons	5,000
6 oz	2 1/2 gallons	2,500
2.5 oz	1 gallon	1,000

For difficult to control weeds, such as sheep sorrel, branched knotweed, chickweed, clover, oxalis or yarrow, repeat application in two weeks using same rate as above.

HOSE ATTACHED SPRAYERS—LAWN MODELS

Use 3 tablespoons of Super D WEEDONE diluted with water to the 3 to 5 gallon mark on the sprayer jar for each 500 square feet (25' x 20') of lawn area to be sprayed. Adjust water pressure so that spray streams about 10-15 feet with no misting. Take usual precautions to prevent spray drift.

AMOUNTS TO USE IN KNAPSACK OR PRESSURE SPRAYERS

AREA SPRAYED	SUPER-D WEEDONE	WATER
200 sq ft (10' x 20')	1 tablespoon	1 gallon
3,200 sq ft (40' x 80')	1 cup (8 fl oz)	10 gallons
6,500 sq ft (65' x 100')	1 pint	20 gallons
13,000 sq ft (130' x 100')	1 quart	30 gallons

Where difficult to control weeds such as sheep sorrel, oxalis, yarrow, clover, chickweed or branched knotweed are a problem, use double the concentration recommended above.

IMPORTANT

Do not use Super-D WEEDONE for controlling weeds in flower or vegetable beds, shrubs or ornamental plantings, Lippia and Dichondra lawns.

This treatment may injure bentgrass, St. Augustine grass, centipede grass, and newly seeded lawns. To control the weeds in these types of grasses use half the rate recommended above.

No weed spraying should be attempted during periods of drought, unless the lawn is watered thoroughly several days before treatment.

A separate sprayer should be kept for weed control because 2,4-D and related chemicals are difficult to clean from equipment.

Do not use this product within the drip line of desirable trees and shrubs as injury to these plants may result.

WEEDS IN FENCEROWS & SIMILAR AREAS

To control large areas of woody brush and vines, ask your dealer for WEEDONE BK 52.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

Avoid spray drift to susceptible plants as this product may injure tomatoes, beans, peas and ornamentals. (Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.) Do not use same spray equipment for other purposes.
