DIRECTIONS: For Use on Lawns

WEEDONE FOAM WEED KILLER is the fast, easy way to kill broadleaf weeds in lawns. The foam kills where you sprayed and helps prevent drift to nearby desirable plants.

Shake well before using.

Hold can upside down 2 to 3 feet above the weeds.

Press valve tab to spray.

Spray just long enough to build up a thin layer of foam on all the leaves on each weed you want to destroy. Do not use excessive amounts of foam, as temporary turf discoloration may result.

WEEDONE FOAM WEED KILLER may be used any time during the year when weeds are growing actively. However, weed kill is quicker and turf grasses fill in faster when spray is applied in the spring or fall.

For large lawn areas infested with weeds, use an overall spray with WEEDONE LAWN WEED KILLER.

CAUTION

Avoid contamination of foods or feed stuffs. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides.
