## DIRECTIONS

### SOYBEANS AND COTTON

#### SUGGESTED BROADCAST RATES PER ACRE

Soil Type	Amount of AMEX
Light Soils—Sand and Sandy Loams	1 1/2 quarts
Medium Soils—Loams and Silt Loams	1 1/2 to 2 quarts
Heavy Soils—Silt Clay Loams and Clay Loams	2 to 3 quarts

#### Preplant Soil Incorporation

For best results, AMEX should be incorporated into the soil at time of spraying or within several hours after spraying. Apply in 10 to 30 gallons of water per acre on a broadcast basis. Operate sprayer pressure at 20 to 40 psi to avoid loss of herbicide by drift. Accurate sprayer calibration is important for most efficient use of chemical.

Thorough incorporation increases the efficiency of AMEX. **Power driven** tillers, hoes or cultivators should be set to operate at a 2 to 3 inch depth. A **double disk** or double disk harrow combination should be set to operate at a depth of 3 to 6 inches. Run the disk in two directions so as to cross-disk and provide uniform incorporation. Incorporate AMEX immediately after application.

Soybeans or cotton may be planted immediately after AMEX incorporation.

#### AERIAL APPLICATION

For aerial application apply AMEX in a minimum of 5 gallons spray mixture per acre. Follow the recommended rates of AMEX based on soil type. Incorporate into soil at the time of spraying or within several hours after application.



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
