The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

Submit five copies of finished printed labeling incorporating the comments listed below before you release the product for shipment:

1. In your Environmental Hazards paragraph delete the statement "Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from area treated."
2. In your Bee Caution paragraph delete "Do not use when value of bees as pollinators is more important than insect control. Before applying, warn beekeepers to locate hives beyond bee flight range until one week after application or to take other equally effective precautions."
