To prepare small amounts, use 1 tablespoon (1/2 fluid ounce) of SEVIMOL-4 per gallon of water.

Lawns, cemeteries and Recreational Areas (including turf, golf courses, and parks) Pastures Rangeland Forested Lands, and Wastelands	1 1/2	Apply a total of 2 gallons of the diluted solution over the surface of each mound or at least 1 quart per 6 inches of mound diameter using a bucket, can or other appropriate equipment. Thoroughly wet mound and surrounding area to a 4 ft. diameter (12 sq. ft.). Do not disturb mounds prior to treatment. Pour solution from a height of about three feet to give sufficient force to break mound apex and flow into ant tunnels. For best results apply in cool weather, 65-80°F, or in early morning or late evening hours. Repeat application if mound activity resumes after 10 days. Treat new mounds as they appear. Pressurized sprays may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness.
