The volume of data submitted August 28, 1985, including acute peroral toxicity and eye irritation studies on this formulation, was assigned Accession Number 259399. Based on the reported results for these studies (oral LD₅₀ > 5000 mg/kg and slight eye irritation clearing in 24 hours), and considering that this product is a water dilution of the concentrate being registered under EPA Registration No. 264-416, we will accept Category III labeling with the additional statement in c above.

Submit the storage stability study for this formulation referred to in your letter of October 25, 1984.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON LAWNS: Super D WEEDONE Brand Weed Killer Ready-To-Use is the fast, easy way to control broadleaf weeds in lawns.

Adjust spray tip to deliver a coarse spray. Hold 2 to 3 feet above the weeds and squeeze handle to spray.

Spray just long enough to wet the leaves on each weed you want to destroy. Do not use excessive amounts of Super D WEEDONE Brand Weed Killer Ready-To-Use, as temporary turf discoloration may result.

Super D WEEDONE Brand Weed Killer Ready-To-Use may be used any time during the year when weeds are growing actively. However, control is quicker and turf grasses fill in faster when spray is applied in the spring or fall. For large lawn areas infested with weeds, use an overall spray with Super D WEEDONE Liquid Herbicide.

Newly seeded areas should not be treated until after they have been mowed at least twice.

To refill sprayer: Add 1 tablespoon of Super D WEEDONE Liquid Herbicide, EPA Reg. No. 264-189-AA, to enough water to make 8 fluid ounces of spray.

To refill sprayer: Add 2 tablespoons of Super D WEEDONE Liquid Herbicide, EPA Reg. No. 264-189-AA, to enough water to make 16 fluid ounces of spray.

To refill sprayer: Add 3 tablespoons of Super D WEEDONE Liquid Herbicide, EPA Reg. No. 264-189-AA, to enough water to make 24 fluid ounces of spray.

To refill sprayer: Add 3 3/4 tablespoons of Super D WEEDONE Liquid Herbicide, EPA Reg. No. 264-189-AA, to enough water to make 30 fluid ounces of spray.
