Dear: Ms. Simila:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

In the tank mix chart, indicate the application rate per acre of Fore WP for the tank mix with Chipco Aliette Extra. The rates must be consistent the rates on the turf tank mix chart for Fore WP on the label of Chipco Aliette WDG Fungicide, EPA Reg. No. 264-515, accepted May 12, 1994.

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

The Agency has completed its review of the subject alternate Confidential Statements of Formula dated September 5, 1995. There is no objection to the use of the alternate formulas requested in your letter of the above date. The amendments have been inserted in the file for the subject product.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE:

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Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is, a violation of Federal Law. CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Do not reuse outer sleeve. Dispose of outer sleeve in the trash

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soluble packet inside can be dropped into the spray tank at the appropriate time without touching it.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

- Do not allow the empty outer sleeve or the tear-strip to fall into the spray tank as they are not water soluble and may clog the sprayer.
- Do not handle the inner packet with wet gloves as the packets will begin to dissolve on contact with even a small amount of water.
- Do not open the inner packets or attempt to remove the contents from them. The water soluble packet is not designed to be remeasured or subdivided.
- The PVA packets should not be opened and partial packets not used for a tankmix.
- The entire contents of the water soluble packet must be used.

DIRECTIONS THROUGH SPRINKLER IRRIGATION SYSTEMS

Apply this product only through sprinkler irrigation systems including microjet, drip, solid set and center pivot. Do not apply this product through any other type of irrigation system.

SPRAY PREPARATION: Remove scale, pesticide residues, and other foreign matter from the chemical tank and entire injector system. Flush with clean water.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: First prepare a suspension of CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA in a mix tank. Fill tank with 1/2 to 3/4 the desired amount of water. Start mechanical or hydraulic agitation. Add the required amount of CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA, and then the remaining volume of water. Then set sprinkler to deliver 0.1 to 0.3 inch of water per acre. Start sprinkler and uniformly inject the suspension of CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA into the irrigation water line so as to deliver the desired rate per acre. The suspension of CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA should be injected with a positive displacement pump into the main line ahead of a right higher turn to insure adequate mixing. If you should have any other questions about calibration, you should contact State Extension Service specialists, equipment manufacturers or other experts.

NOTE: For Microjet and Drip Irrigation Systems: When treatment with CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA has been completed, further field irrigation over the treated area should be avoided for 24 to 48 hours. For Solid Set and Center Pivot Irrigation Systems: When treatment with CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA has been completed, further field irrigation over the treated area should be avoided until foliage is dry to prevent washing the chemical off the crop.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS FOR APPLICATIONS THROUGH SPRINKLER IRRIGATION SYSTEMS

Maintain continuous agitation in mix tank during mixing and application to assure a uniform suspension.

The system must contain a functional check valve, vacuum relief valve, and low pressure drain appropriately located on the irrigation pipeline to prevent water source contamination from backflow. The pesticide injection pipeline must contain a functional, automatic, quick-closing check valve to prevent the flow of fluid back toward the injection pump. The pesticide injection pipeline must also contain a functional, normally closed solenoid operated valve located on the intake side of the injection pump and connected to the system interlock to prevent fluid from being withdrawn from the supply tank when the irrigation system is either automatically or manually shutdown. The system must contain functional interlocking controls to automatically shut off the pesticide injection pump when the water pump motor stops. The irrigation line or water pump must include a functional pressure switch which will stop the water pump motor when the water pressure decreases to the point where pesticide distribution is adversely affected. Systems must use a metering pump, such as a positive displacement injection pump (e. g., diaphragm pump) effectively designed and constructed of materials that are compatible with pesticides and capable of being fitted with a system interlock.

o not apply when wind speed favors drift, when system connection or fittings leak, when nozzles do not provide uniform distribution or when lines containing the product must be dismantled and drained.

Crop injury, lack of effectiveness, or illegal pesticide residues in the crop may result from nonuniform distribution of treated water. Allow sufficient time for pesticide to be flushed through all lines and all nozzles before turning off irrigation water. A person knowledgeable of the chemigation system and responsible for its operation shall shut the system down and make necessary adjustments should the need arise. Do not connect an irrigation system (including greenhouse systems) used for pesticide application to a public water system unless the label-prescribed safety devices for public water supplies are in place.

TURF

CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA is a systemic fungicide which may be used in a seasonal program for the control of Pythium diseases, such as blight and root rot, and Yellow tuft on common turfgrasses on golf courses, sod farms and other turf areas. Apply as a foliar spray, using 1 to 5 galfons of water per 1,000 sq. ft., as indicated in the table below. Apply with a properly galiprated sprayer.

Begin preventive applications when conditions first favor disease and repeat at recommended interval. Do not mow and/or water treated areas until foliage is completely dry. Maintain agitation during spray operations.

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COMPATIBILITY

CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA may not be compatible with foliar fertilizers or with copper based fungicides. Do not mix CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA with any sticker, extender or wetting agent.

To determine the physical compatibility of CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA with any other product, use a small container to mix a small amount (e.g. 1 pint) of spray solution, containing all ingredients in the same order and ratio as the anticipated use. If any indication of physical incompatibility develop, do not use this mixture for spraying. Indication of incompatibility usually appear within 5-15 minutes after mixing. Read and follow all directions and precautions on this label and on the labels of any products for which a tank mixture is being considered.

CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA is not physically compatible with flowable formulations of Daconil 2787® fungicides as a tank mixture. These products should not be combined for application.

Do not graze animals on treated turf. Do not feed clippings from treated turf to livestock and poultry.

Summer Stress Complex: For control of summer stress complex caused by a complex of *Pythium* and *Rhizoctonia* diseases, CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA can be tank-mixed with Fore® WP Fungicide on common turigrasses on golf courses, sod farms, industrial or municipal turif areas, and professional applications to residential lawns.

Additional Disease Control: If turf is threatened by additional diseases, CHPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA is compatible with most commonly used fungicides. For control of diseases such as Dollar Spot, Brown Patch, Helminthosporium Leaf Spot, and Necrotic Ring Spot, CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA can be tank-mixed with CHIPCO® 26019 or CHIPCO® 26019 FLO brand fungicides. Consult the CHIPCO® 26019 and CHIPCO® 26019 FLO labels for a complete listing of diseases controlled and for application rates.

If a tank-mix with other fungicides is used, follow label directions for the use of that product and apply at the recommended rate for control of the target disease organism. CHIPCO® ALIETTE® EXTRA is not compatible with the flowable formulations of Daconil 2787® or Fore® Fungicide. These products should not be combined for application.
