NOTE TO USER

Product should be used within 4-6 months from date of manufacture. The date of manufacture is stamped on front of container.

ALIETTE® INJECTABLE is sold in a form which is ready to be injected directly into the tree. Do not dilute ALIETTE® injectable or add any other chemicals to the solution.

Clean the injectors thoroughly after use and dispose of wash water where it will not contaminate food, grazing or water sources.

BEARING AVOCADO (TRUNK INJECTION)

When used in conjunction with good cultural management practices, ALIETTE® is effective in controlling Avocado Root Rot (*Phytophthora sp.*) ALIETTE® applications (injections) should be applied in accordance with the table below:

APPLICATION TYPE	RATES	APPLICATION TIMING
Trunk Injection (60 ml injectors)	Do not exceed a total of 200 ml of ALIETTE® injectable per tree per year. The rates of ALIETTE® injectable needed per syringe are detailed in the application volume table below:	Apply when conditions are favorable for disease development (i.e. Spring and Fall). Do not exceed 2 injections per year. Do not apply within 60 days of harvest.

INJECTION INSTRUCTIONS

- Drill Injection Holes:** Drill the required number of holes in the trunk. The holes must be spaced evenly around the trunk circumference and be 6-12 inches up from base of the tree. Their diameter will depend on the application equipment being used. The holes should be about 50mm deep and should be angled slightly downwards into the trunk.
- Fill the Syringes:** A syringe is filled by drawing up the desired amount of ALIETTE® injectable, inverting the syringe and pulling the plunger back further to fill the remainder of the syringe with air.
- Apply the Injection:** Insert the tip of the syringe into one of the holes in the tree trunk ensuring a tight fit which will not leak when pressure is applied. Depress the plunger, compressing the air into syringe, then fix the plunger in this position, thus maintaining the pressure. The compressed air in the syringe will help force the ALIETTE® into the tree. Repeat this process with all the holes that have been drilled. When the tree has taken up all the ALIETTE® in the syringes, remove them and apply a small quantity of a wound-healing compound to the holes.
