If Swallowed: Call a physician or poison control center. Give 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

- c. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:
May be fatal if swallowed, absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Causes eye injury. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, or using tobacco. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Do not breathe dust. Wear a mask or pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mine Safety and Health Administration and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health.
- d. Revise the Environmental Hazards Statement to read as follows:
This product is toxic to birds, fish, and aquatic invertebrates. - i. Revise the last sentence of the warranty statement to read as follows:
In no event shall manufacturer or seller be liable for special, indirect, or consequential damages resulting

from the use or handling of this product when use or handling is not in accordance with label directions.

- j. Add the Net Weight to the label.
- 3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
