4. Submit by June 30, 2006 the following Studies conducted on accordance with the Good Laboratory Practice Standards, 40 CFR Part 160 and appropriate test guidelines as referenced in EPA's Data Requirements for Registration Regulations, 40 CFR Part 158:

a. Additional storage stability data for mustard greens and turnips to validate the submitted field rotational crop study.

b. Monitoring of "carboxylic acid" degradate to determine if it is accumulating in ponds, lakes and reservoirs near propoxycarbazone use areas.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
